Eagle Scout required merit badges

Not recommended for first year scouts

Troop and non merit badge activities

Small boat sailing is 75mins so count as two periods as you figure your schedule

There is a long walk to the sailing area, it is better to sign up for the 10:30 session which allows 40mins from the end of session 1 to walk to Lowes Lake.

First Aid and Emergency Preparedness are restricted to 1st Class and above

Scouts need extra practise for rowing, canoeing and swimming outside of class

You should consider taking Canoeing in your second or third year for troop canoe trips

Must be 12+ at camp to take Rifle merit badge or rifle shoot

Must be 13+ at camp to take Shotgun merit badge or shotgun shoot
